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
Barbara van Druten




































































Laura González Cabrera





Laura González Cabrera (Las Palmas de Gran Canarias, 1976) graduated from the Faculty of Fine Arts of Salamanca. In 2015 she received the DKV award for the best Spanish artist and in 2009 she won the gold medal in the international competition in Barranquilla, Colombia, together with the architect Evelyn Alonso-Rohner within the Miami + Beach Architecture Biennial. She has also been awarded a scholarship by the City of Paris to carry out a residency at the Centre Les Récollets (2019).


She has had solo exhibitions at the Nova Invaliden Gallery in Berlin, the Ángeles Baños Gallery in Badajoz, the Marta Cervera Gallery in Madrid and the Atlantic Centre for Modern Art (CAAM) in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, among others. She has produced mural paintings in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Santa Cruz de Tenerife, A Coruña, Murcia, Madrid, Naples, Turin, Milan, Dakar and Beijing. Her work is represented in the DKV collection, the Canary Islands Foundation for the Development of Painting in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, the Atlantic Centre for Modern Art (CAAM) in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria and in numerous private collections.

The word and its staging in space has been one of the main axes of development of Laura González Cabrera's work. This explains her interest in writing and painting as a record of an action. The form thus becomes the residue of a practice, the gesture becomes a minimum unit of information and its reiteration a kind of "mantra". It is a gesture computed and ordered in reticular structures where color, stroke and letter invite the viewer to scrutinize the surfaces in search of meaning. Its entire process is determined in advance through numerical, chromatic, and geometric rules of transformation and is materialized by a procedure that rigorously responds to invariable protocols close to those of a ritual. In it, she connects the visible with the invisible, that is, the written word with the experience it evokes, a link that translates into a symbolic illegibility.



















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



























